In order to properly execute your Iowa Statutory General Power of Attorney, you simply need to follow these three steps:

1. Read the document to make sure you understand it.
2. Enter your initials where appropriate on page 2 of the Iowa Statutory General Power of Attorney.
3. Sign page 3 of the Iowa Statutory General Power of Attorney in the presence of a notary.

Once your Iowa Statutory General Power of Attorney has been signed and notarized, you should make a copy for your personal use and put the original in a safe place, like a personal safe or a safety deposit box.

2. Sign page 3 of the Iowa Statutory General Power of Attorney in the presence of a notary.

Once your Nonstatutory Health Care Power of Attorney has been signed and notarized/, you should make a copy for your personal use and put the original in a safe place, like a personal safe or a safety deposit box.
